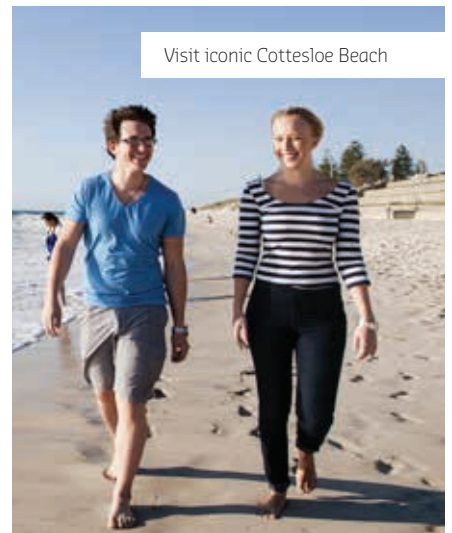

Off campus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • a range of options available in surrounding suburbs • rental prices vary depending on location and type of accommodation.

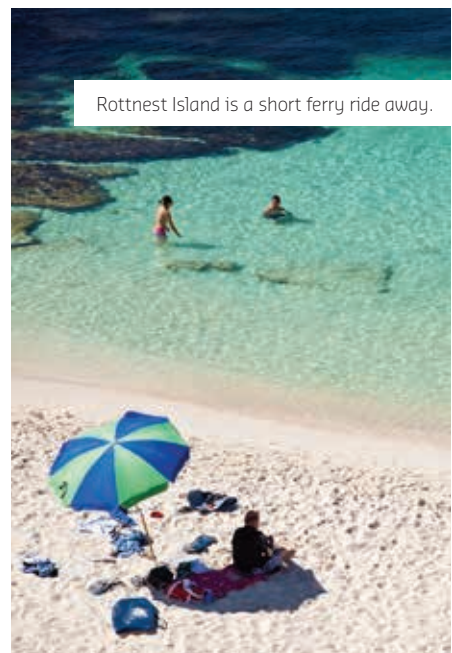


Why study in Perth?
